In Loving Memory of...

Richard Daniel "Dick" Bass, who passed away Sunday, July 26, 2015 at the age of 85 surrounded by family in Dallas, Texas. Bass suffered from pulmonary fibrosis.

Born Dec. 21, 1929 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Bass co-founded Snowbird Ski and Summer Resort in 1971 with Ted Johnson and maintained sole ownership of the Utah resort for four decades until the Bass family sold majority interest in Snowbird to Ian Cumming in May 2014. "The Snowbird family is mourning the loss of a great man who changed so many of our lives for the better," said Snowbird President Bob Bonar, who worked for Bass since before the resort opened.

He is survived by wife Alice, four children and 13 grandchildren as well as five stepchildren and 11 step grandchildren. Bass was known for his love of poetry, art, travel, literature and people. A conversation with Bass was never brief but always entertaining with his homespun aphorisms he called "Bassisms." Dick Bass will be remembered and missed.

Important House Rule Reminders

Iron Blossam is always a popular and busy place. Compliance with the House Rules helps all Owners and guests enjoy their valuable vacation time. We want to remind our owners that in addition to being respectful of the Iron Blossam House Rules, it is also very important that your guests are informed of and respect the House Rules. A complete set of House Rules is available on our website, or by contacting Iron Blossam Owner Services. We do want to highlight some key areas of frequent concern.

Compliance with House Rules:

House Rule #21: Failure to comply with any Iron Blossam Lodge house rule or policy of the Owners' Association may result in the forfeiture of the remainder of your week. Additionally, owners are financially accountable for any damages, conduct or policy violations, and unpaid charges.

West Pool Age Restrictions:

The West pool, spa area, steam room, hot tub and exercise room are restricted to Owners and guests who are 16 years of age and older. The usage of the Iron Blossam pool and spa facilities is available to resident Owners and registered guest in accordants with the occupancy limits of the unit.

Disturbances:

House Rule #3: No owners or occupant shall make or permit disturbing conduct or activities to be made in the units, common areas or pool and spa areas by himself/herself or their family, friends, tenants, servants or other invitees or other individuals over whom they have control, nor do or permit to be done by such persons anything that would interfere with the rights, comforts, or conveniences of other owners or occupants.

Minimum Age Requirement:

House Rule #20: The Iron Blossam Owners' Association requires that an adult (minimum age 21) register and be in residence the entire length of stay.

We've been busy!:

Each May and November we schedule multiple maintenance and renovations during the scheduled maintenance weeks. Not every project can be completed in the short time allowed: therefore, many are completed in phases. We want to highlight some of the projects and changes completed.

Beginning with the maintenance period in May 2015 renovations included: new 5th floor hallway carpet, replacement of draperies in the suites, studio and bedroom style units, and the coffee tables, end tables and nightstands have been replaced in the majority of units. With the final phase of furniture being completed for the remaining rooms 318-324 with the addition of new sofas. Showers in the men's dry sauna have been renovated. The first phase of installation of new art in all rooms was started and it is anticipated this project will be completed in November. Renovation of the bathroom vanity cabinets began and this is also anticipated to be completed in November. Also scheduled for November 2015 is the renovating and updating of the aging arcade area with a new look and amenities. The main lobby is also scheduled to be renovated. No special assessments will be required for the above-mentioned renovations.

Check-In/Out

We realize, and love the fact, that our owners are always very eager to arrive and start their vacation at the Iron Blossam.

We want to remind everyone that occupancy of owner units begins at 4:00 p.m. However, the final completion of housekeeping services may continue past that time. Units may only be occupied when housekeeping services are complete. We appreciate your respect for the 10:00 a.m. check out time. Late check outs delay the occupancy for the next weeks owner. Saturdays from 9 to 10:00 a.m. and 4 to 6:00 p.m. are prime check-in/out times and are therefore extremely busy. During these hours, please be aware that our aging elevators, our staff, and our loading areas are most likely extended to capacity. Thank you for your patience during these surges in operating levels.

The Iron Blossam staff provides luggage storage for early arrivals or late departures.

Helpful Hints

Plan ahead! Pre-load your vehicle the night before with unneeded items.

If convenient, depart earlier than our peak check-out time - 9 to 10:00 a.m. If convenient, arrive later than peak check-in time - 4 to 6:00 p.m. Owner occupancy does not begin until 4:00 p.m. - therefore we do not suggest early arrivals. Units may not be occupied until the completion of housekeeping services. Please do not keep luggage carts for extended periods or overnight.
